NATIONAL TROPHIES

National Trophies can only be awarded to members of Camellias Australia Inc.

They are perpetual trophies to be held by the recipients for twelve months.

Trophies will be presented at our Opening Ceremony – around 3pm on Saturday 11th July, 2015

The Dr Don Aspinall Award for the Best Bloom of an Australian Raised Non-Reticulata Cultivar.

The Albury-Wodonga Award for the Best Bloom of an Australian Raised Reticulata.

The Barry Robbins Memorial Award for the Best Cut or Spray (or single bloom) of a Multi-Clustered Miniature Cultivar.

The New Zealand Camellia Award for the Best Bloom of a New Zealand Raised Cultivar.

The American Camellia Award for the Best Bloom of an American Raised Cultivar.

The Westfield Camellia Award for the Best Bloom of an Overseas Raised Cultivar, other than America or New Zealand.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR ALL EXHIBITORS IN BLOOM COMPETITION

- 1 Entries are free, and are open to all.
 - 2 The hall will be open at **7AM** and entries will be accepted up to **11 AM on SATURDAY**, when all persons except judges & stewards must leave the competitive areas to facilitate judging.
 - 3 Containers are provided for all classes and must be used.
 - 4 Individual blooms in Sections A-I should have no more than two (2) leaves and no buds.
 - 5 Named cultivars include their sports and variegated forms, unless these are listed separately.
 - 6 **Exhibitors' name cards are available from Show Stewards, or may be made at home from WHITE cardboard for Camellias Australia members/affiliates, or COLOURED cardboard, eg pink, for members of the public.**
 - (a) One card is to be placed in front of each entry with the exhibitor's name face down. For named classes the upper side of the card should remain blank.
 - (b) For unnamed classes the upper side is to show correct cultivar or species name (except Section K)
 - 7 Not more than two (2) entries per exhibitor are permitted in classes for named cultivars. In other classes entries are restricted to two (2) per cultivar per exhibitor.
 - 8 Gibbed blooms are not permitted.
 - 9 Spraying of exhibits on the show bench is prohibited.
 - 10 Use of artificial aids is prohibited in Sections A-I, except for inconspicuously securing a bloom to its original foliage by pin or wire.
 - 11 Interfering with or moving other exhibitors' entries is prohibited. Only Show Stewards are permitted to move exhibits to provide space, ensure blooms are entered in the correct classes, or to check compliance with conditions of entry. Breach of the conditions of entry may result in disqualification of an exhibitor's entry or entries, at the discretion of the Show Stewards.
 - 12 Certificates/ribbons and all Awards are to remain on the tables until closure of the Show at 4pm Sunday, and exhibitors must collect them before 5.30 pm on that day, unless special arrangements have been made with the Show Manager.
 - 13 All exhibits will be judged according to the standards and rules of the NSW Camellia Research Society Inc, and the decisions of the judges will be final.
 - 14 **Individual Form Champion blooms will be selected from Sections A to G only.**
 - 15 All exhibits remain the property of the Society.
 - 16 All entries must be from the exhibitor's own plants, owned for at least 3 months.
 - 17 Judges may exhibit in all sections, but are expected to use discretion when judging.
 - 18 Camellias not registered, or commercially or widely distributed, are only eligible in Section K.
- 19 **AWARDS:**
- i) **Certificates** for 1st and 2nd place in all classes, and Commended seedlings in Section K, will be awarded at the judges' discretion, in each class.
 - ii) **Champion Sashes** will be awarded for **Champion Camellia of the Show**, Each of the 5 **Form Champions (Single; Semi-double/Irregular Semi-double; Elegans Form; Informal Double; Formal Double)** and **Champion Collection**.
 - iii) **Points** will be allotted as follows:-
5 points - Champion Collection & Champion Camellia of the Show;
4 points - individual Champion Blooms
3 points – each 1st place in Section I classes (Collections)
2 points – each 1st place in Sections A - H classes and each 2nd place in Section I classes (Collections)
1 point —each 2nd place in Sections A – H classes
 - iv) **Prizes – Cultural Classes (Sections A – I):**
 - ❖ **Point Score competition** : Several places receive prizes
 - ❖ **Champion Prizes:** Champion Camellia of Show, the other Form Champions and Champion Collection receive prizes.
 - ❖ **The R & G O'Conor Prize**, donated by Rachel & Geoffrey O'Conor, for the best Collection
 - ❖ **The Murray Moyes Memorial Prize**, donated by the Moyes family, for a bloom chosen from **classes 49, 73 or 81**
 - ❖ **The Beth Bond Memorial Prize**, donated by Lindsay Bond, for Best **Winter's Own Variegated (class 150)**.
 - ❖ **The Lindsay Bond Prize**, donated by Lindsay Bond for the Best Reticulata otherwise un-awarded
 - ❖ **The Higo Prize**, donated by Elizabeth & Chris Navin for the Best Higo otherwise un-awarded
 - ❖ **The Miniature Prize**, donated by Elizabeth Navin for the Best Miniature otherwise un-awarded
 - ❖ **The President's Prize**, donated by **Richie Griffiths for a bloom of his choice**
 - ❖ **EDEN GARDENS NORTH RYDE PRIZE**
 - ❖ **YATES PRIZES**
 - ❖ **HARGRAVES NURSERYLAND, DURAL, Voucher Prizes**
